## Kristi Walters Promoted to Director of The Duke Endowment's Higher Education Program Area

CHARLOTTE, NC (January 17, 2023) – The Duke Endowment is pleased to announce that Kristi Walters has been promoted to director of its Higher Education program area. Walters served as associate director before moving into her current role.

Walters joined the Endowment in 2019. For the past three years, she has worked with the four Endowment-supported schools – Davidson College, Duke University, Furman University and Johnson C. Smith University – to understand their priorities, determine how the Endowment might provide the best support for long-term impact and identify opportunities to learn and pursue shared objectives that strengthen the institutions. In this new role, Walters will manage the Endowment's Higher Education program area, continuing to work closely with leaders at the four institutions to assist them in achieving their strategic objectives.

Before coming to the Endowment, Walters served as an Interfaith Program Fellow, program officer and senior advisor to the president at the Arthur Vining Davis Foundations. Prior to that, she was a practicing attorney at Parker Poe Adams & Bernstein LLP in Charlotte. She also worked in the admission offices at Davidson College and Duke University.

"I look forward to our continued partnership with the four institutions the Endowment supports to promote their long-term success so that they may continue to effectively serve their students and the Carolinas."
