***Stacy Warren Promoted to Associate Director of The Duke Endowment’s Health Care Program Area***

CHARLOTTE, NC (January 17, 2023) – The Duke Endowment is pleased to announce that Stacy Warren has been promoted to associate director of its Health Care program area. Warren served as a program officer before moving into her current role.

Warren joined the Endowment in 2014. For the past eight years, she has primarily focused on improving health care outcomes for children. In addition to leading the Endowment’s support of a large school-based oral health initiative, she focuses on pediatric and adolescent school-based health programs as well as efforts to improve mental health. Warren has also supported projects that center on safer prescribing practices for opioids.

Before coming to the Endowment, Warren worked at the North Carolina Office of Rural Health and Community Care in Raleigh, where she was responsible for managing programs focused on improving the quality of health care for children. Prior to that, she worked at an assessment center for foster children with a Raleigh-based nonprofit that provides mental health services across the state.

“I am grateful to be part of an organization that, for nearly 100 years, has recognized the importance of supporting programs and initiatives that promote good health and provide essential health care services to people living in the Carolinas,” said Warren. “I look forward to continuing the Endowment’s work with our partners to reduce barriers to care and improve health outcomes.”
